REPORTS:

Fire Report: – Forest Rural Fire: (AREC supplied Comms / Logistics to Forestry Fire Teams).

Sat. 14/12/19.- Two Forestry units, assistance call to a grass and scrub fire threatening trees in the former Eyrewell Forest area. This required resources called in from a large area including at least one helicopter.

Fri. 27/12/19. - Two Forestry units, assistance call to a ute and a paddock on fire near North Loburn. The ute was destroyed.

Wed. 1/1/20. - Two Forestry units, assistance call to a tractor on fire in a hay paddock near North Loburn.

Mon. 6/1/20. - One Forestry unit, assistance rescue call to a car-v-pole near North Loburn. First Response (Rangiora) deemed assistance not required and stood down the Forestry unit.

Sat. 11/1/20. -Two separate call-outs on a day of hot, gusty N-W winds.

- (1) One Forestry unit assistance call to a hedge on fire near Loburn. Found to have self-extinguished so unit stood down while en route.
- (2) Three Forestry units in major call-out to hedge and paddock fires threatening property in Loburn area. CHCH Command Unit and a helicopter also included in this call-out. One property owner required treatment by Ambulance.

Wed. 15/1/20. - (1) One Forestry unit, assistance call to smoke in the area of Leithfield. First arrival (Amberley) found a permitted, controlled burn and stood down other responding units.

(2) One Forestry unit, assistance call to investigate a smouldering bonfire, late evening. Turned out to be minor and all units stood down.

Sat. 18/1/20. - Two Forestry units assisting in trying to locate source of smoke initially in the Okuku area but there was much confusion because of the low cloud around the hills. One of our units finally located the smoke in the North Loburn area. Found to be a permitted burn but the owner had forgotten to advise Firecom before lighting up.

Wed. 22/1/20. - One Forestry unit, assistance call to a paddock and header harvester on fire up the Waipara Gorge near Broomfield.

Sat. 1/2/20.- Three Forestry units, assistance call to scrub fire, north side of Ashley River near Loburn. Had been spotted by small aircraft approaching Rangiora airfield. 4WD units required. Very difficult to locate and deal with.

Sun. 2/2/20. - Three Forestry units, assistance call to major scrub fire, same area as previous day and continuing as a multiple day event and difficult to control in the hot, windy N-W conditions prevailing at the time. Stood down overnight.

Mon. 3/2/20. The Forestry units recalled (at 3.20am) to fire out of control, mostly on property protection work until late that night. They were not required again though the fire took at least a further day to finally extinguish. This fire required wide ranging resources, fire pumps, tankers, heavy machinery and helicopters

Then the 40M antenna was raised on Grant ZL2GD's portable mast and we settled down to wait for the start of the contest.

We started steadily and proceeded at this pace for the entire contest, which I think was the reason we put in a fairly respectable score of 227,304pts which is a great improvement over last year's score of 128,180pts.

There was a significant amount of rain that started soon after the commencement of the contest, but luckily it cleared up for the Sunday.
