Repeater Reports



Mount Grey 675 Repeater

On 19th September the existing FM repeater was replaced by a Yaesu Fusion FM/Digital repeater. For FM operation now, a ctcss subtone of 123.0 is required on both the tx and rx of radios to be able to

work it.

Mount Noble 6975 Repeater

This repeater failed in late March due, it is believed, to a faulty controller. On the 28 th August, Tim ZL3TIM and Matt ZL3MAT climbed up to the repeater, hopefully to get it operational again. Unfortunately, this was unable to be achieved and the faulty unit has been brought down to be repaired on the bench. A video of their trip has been circulated to Branch members and is hoped to be shown at a future meeting and with accompanying explanations.

Report on the replacement of the 675 repeater

After meeting at lake Janet at 1130hrs 2 four-wheel drives and Geoff in his small car headed up the 5km 15 min drive up to the Kordia tower.

After arriving at the top at 1155 and checking out the views Richard ZL4FZ then gained access to the building and then with the help of Mike ZL3TMB and others passing equipment removed the old analog repeater, tested the antenna and installed the new repeater. By 1315 hrs the new Fusion Analog repeater was switched on and tested.

We had Jim ZL3ND from Methven and Harry ZL4HK from Kaikoura use the Fusion side of the repeater. Richard ZL4FZ gave us a small talk on the inside racks and the antenna.

The Kordia tower is 43 meters high at a height of 920 meters with Branch 68 antenna at the top so Branch 68 antenna is 963 meters high. The Summit is 330 meters to the north at 934 meters high and there is also a commercial repeater with 2 wooden poles and a hut about 30 meters to the north of the Kordia tower.

The repeater is 20.5 km north of the Waimakariri council office in High St Rangiora.

After the repeater was commissioned Richard ZL4FZ walked up to the summit to activate Sota on VHF,HF and make contact with ZL and VK.

I made contact on VHF simplex into Christchurch and the top of Mt Pleasant.

The weather was nice and warm in the sun with some cloud cover at times but not too windy. There were some patches of snow on the side of the road going up and on the grass area up at the repeater after the southerly came through on Thursday night.

Geoff ZL3QR was a little concerned the day before this could make to trip up the track to the top of Mt Grey somewhat difficult.

We headed down about 1530hrs and then met at the Amberly pub for refreshments and review on the afternoons work.

The 146.750 - split now needs a CTCSS Tone of 123.0 to TX and receive the repeater as you will hear data sound without the tone and not be able to TX the repeater.
